Currently, 56.7% of the 54,417 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.0%, renter occupied; and 9.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 52,751 housing units in the area - 59.4% owner occupied, 31.6% renter occupied, and 9.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.39%. Median home value in the area is \$73,468, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.01% annually to \$85,197.
