Currently, 58.8% of the 28,141 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 28.7%, renter occupied; and 12.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 27,234 housing units in the area - 61.3% owner occupied, 26.9% renter occupied, and 11.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.47%. Median home value in the area is \$93,318, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.05% annually to \$119,383.
