NORTH CAROLINA'S NUMBER ONE INDUSTRY

Agriculture and agribusiness -food, fiber and forestry — account for one-sixth of the state's income and employees. More than 16 percent, or nearly \$76 billion of the \$471 billion gross state product is contributed by food, fiber and forestry industries.
